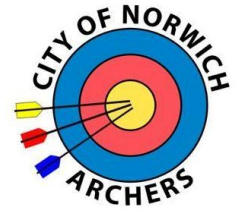

60cm full face will be used for all disciplines, except compound who will use a 60cm vertical triple spot face.

The shoot will be run to World Archery timing Rules using the Danage system of timing and lights, and archers will shoot in one detail during session one and two details during sessions 2 and 3, AB and CD.
